HOW TO USE OUR SODAMAHER



REMOVE REAR COVER

Grasp the back cover with the right hand, press the release button and push upward.



INSTALL CYLINDERS

Hold the machine on your left hand, put the cylinder in the slot with your right hand, and rotate the cylinder into the machine clockwise.



INSTALL REAR COVER

Grasp the middle of the rear cover with your right hand, Hook the fuselage correctly and push forward.



INSTALL WATER BOTTLE

Pour water up to the max waterline indicated on the bottle, push the gas-up frontal button and screw the bottle clockwise.



CARBONATION

Press the button for approx. 1 second to start the carbonation, after 3-5 pressure you will hear a background noise, it is the opening of the valve.



REMOVE THE WATER BOTTLE

Press the button with the written gas-up on it and let it vent, after remove the bottle, it's possible have some loss of co2 from the back valve of the sodamaker.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

NEVER CARBONATE ANYTHING OTHER THAN PLAIN WATER

When carbonating, a small amount of liquid could bubble up through the valves.

If the water contains sugar or other compounds the valves could not working properly and the product could potentially be dangerous to use.

Never add fruit slice, ice and flavours in the water bottle.

Use a pitcher or mix it directly in your glass.


Rinse the water bottle carefully before filling it with water.



Don't put fruits, vegetables or herbs in the water bottle before carbonating.



Don't put flavours or syrup into the water bottle before carbonating.



Don't put ice in the water bottle before carbonating.



Never store the bottle in freezer.



Don't carbonate juice or milk.



Don't carbonate wine.




Don't give new life to old flat soda.

SAFETY GUIDELINES


NEVER CLEAN THE WATER BOTTLE IN THE DISHWASHER

The water bottle is designed to withstand pressures up to double the working pressure of the carbonator. However, this ability is quickly destroyed if the bottle is exposed to heat above 40 degrees celsius. Most dishwashers operate at very high temperatures so therefore never put the bottle in the dishwasher.




KEEP THE SPARKLING WATER AWAY FROM POTENTIAL SOURCE OF HEAT.

Italia sodamaker is designed to be used with room temperature cylinder. If the cylinder gets too hot it can be dangerous to use the machine.



Don't place the sparkling water maker close to sunny window.



Don't place the sparkling water maker close to a hot radiator.



Don't place the sparkling water maker close to an open flame.



Don't use the sodamaker in extreme weather conditions.

PAY ATTENTION

NOTES ON THE MACHINE OPERATION

1. Please refer to the parts indicated in the manual to see if all the parts are complete, if you find any damage or loss, please contact the manufacturer or dealer.
2. Before use, please read the instruction carefully and strictly.
3. The water added should never exceed the highest water level, do not add any fruit dew, syrup, etc..
4. Unscrew the bottle only when the sodamaker is not working.
5. Do not unscrew the cylinder without unscrewing the water bottle.

DAILY MAINTENANCE

USE AND MAINTENANCE OF SODA DISPENSER

1. After each use, please clean the fuselage carefully, do not use sharp tools to avoid damages.
2. When transporting, make sure that the cylinder are not into the soda dispense.
3. If it is not used for a long time, please clean the machine, dry it and place it in the package box.

WATER BOTTLE USE AND MAINTENANCE

1. The water bottle is made of food-grade PET materials, and it is usually scratchproof.
2. Do not heat above 30°C.
3. Use a mild detergent to clean it, cool and dry in a place shielded from the sun.
4. Do not carbonate the bottle without adding water.
5. If the bottle has been deformed, damaged or the service life has come to an end, please replace the bottle in time.

DAILY MAINTENANCE

USE AND MAINTENANCE CYLINDERS


1. Co2 cylinders are pressure vessels, keep away from sharp instruments, fire, electricity, etc..., stored in shade.
2. When you use the cylinder the surface of the cylinder will quickly cool down, pay attention to prevent freezing hands.
3. As the cylinder valve is a precision part, the non-professional must not remove it, the valve must be always clean.
4. If the cylinder should leak, check the presence or the correct position of the gasket present in the housing where the cylinder is screwed.
5. Cylinders are refillable, professionals will check, maintain and test the cylinder's tightness each time it is refilled.

WARRANTY OF THE PRODUCT

1. The sodamaker has a 2 years warranty.
2. After purchase, if the machine is dismantled by an unauthorized person, the damage caused is not covered by the warranty.
3. Use it exclusively with gas-up accessories.
